Campervan Policy August 2021

The committee will trial and monitor the following campervan policy with immediate effect until the AGM.

1. Socialising
 - a. Socialising will be free for those in self-sufficient alternative accommodation (campervans, B&B etc), including attending communal meals.
 - b. Occasionally hostel rules will not permit non-residents to enter, or may request a donation.
2. Hostel policy on campervans
 - a. If hostel policy is known in advance, it will be noted in the newsletter.
 - b. Campervanners should inform the meet coordinator of their intention to attend. The meet coordinator will liaise with the hostel to determine any existing policy. This prevents the hostel managers from being contacted by multiple campervanners.
 - c. Campervanning outside the hostel may not be possible or permitted in some locations.
3. Charges
 - a. The hostel charges and conditions for campervans should be respected if these exist. Campervanners should pay any charges direct to the hostel. Club finances and club cancellation insurance are not involved.
 - b. If the hostel does not charge, and campervanners are not self-sufficient, they pay £6 per person per night to the club (ideally by bank transfer) for access to all the communal areas in the hostel. This does not include any club cancellation insurance.
4. Effects of the policy
 - a. When campervanners pay a reduced amount to use the facilities and attend a meet which is not fully booked, there will be a loss compared to them paying the full charge.
 - b. It is hoped that this will be balanced by gains made when they attend a fully booked meet.
